

Dear Quivira Park Family Dental Patients,

The American Dental Association and the Kansas Dental Board have recommended dental offices suspend all non-emergency dental treatment, to help stop the spread of COVID-19. With this in mind, we will be suspending routine/elective treatment in our office until further notice.

We will remain open for urgent/emergency care, such as:

Severe toothache/ pain

Swelling of gums, face, or neck

Bleeding in your mouth that does not stop

Infection or a substantial risk of it

Trauma (such as a broken tooth)

If you are unsure if your situation is urgent or an emergency, please call us to further discuss. We will be observing shortened office hours during this time period, Monday- Thursday from 9am-1pm. As always, if you have an after-hours emergency, call the office and follow the prompts to have your call forwarded to Dr. Olson.

We will continue to screen for recent or current fevers, recent travel to an area where there are more documented cases of COVID-19, known contact with infected persons, current symptoms (dry cough, fever, body aches etc). Anyone suspected of possibly having COVID-19 may not receive treatment in our facility, but rather will be helped in getting tested and treated in a facility better suited to prevent the spread of the illness.

All other appointments will be rescheduled until notice from the Kansas Dental Board and/or CDC that we may resume normal operations. We will be reaching out to our patients with scheduled appointments to postpone these appointments. If you have any questions for us during this time, please do not hesitate to call.
